I wanted to update you on a few safety measures we are taking to ensure we are doing our part to follow the most up to date CDC guidelines to reduce the spread of the coronavirus on campus and in housing. We're asking all people living in on campus housing to immediately make the following changes to daily life:

- For the foreseeable future, we are suspending guests in on campus housing
- Please maintain a distance of at least 6 feet while communicating with others
- Please refrain from attending gatherings with more than 10 people
- Please leave housing and enter other public spaces only when absolutely necessary until the end of March (grocery stores, pharmacies, doctor's offices, hospitals, etc) and be sure when leaving one environment and heading into another to thoroughly wash your hands following CDC guidelines - if working at a job - please consult with your roommate to be sure you are both on the same page as to each other's whereabouts and the people you're in contact with and be extremely careful to follow proper sanitizing measures when leaving for/returning from work
- Please alert a staff member on your campus IMMEDIATELY if you begin to show symptoms of the coronavirus (fever, dry cough, shortness of breath, etc) and self-quarantine for 14 days from the start of the symptoms
- If moving out of housing for remainder of semester, contact Brittany Janiszewski to schedule a checkout time and ensure house cleaning is up to standard.
- **\*\*NO ONE MAY CHECK OUT OF HOUSING WITHOUT STUDENT LIFE STAFF APPROVAL**
