

Bachelor's in Guitar Audition Requirements

Video Audition Instructions

You, the prospective student, must create and upload a 15-minute maximum video with the following components (combine the 4 elements into ONE video). The components of the video must be done in one continuous take, with no edits. Have your backing track, metronome, etc. ready!

1. With a metronome at 80 BPM (play eighth notes):
 - perform 2 octaves of the Bb major scale in TWO locations,
 - perform 2 patterns of the G major pentatonic scale,
 - and 2 patterns of the D minor pentatonic scale.
2. Play these chords in order (one of each).
 - C Major, F minor, Bb7, Eb Major, Ab minor, Db7, F# Major, B minor, E7, A Major, D minor, G7. **NO OPEN POSITION CHORDS**
3. Perform a song that best represents your preferred stylistic genre and ability.
 - The song may include other musicians, play-along tracks or original recordings.
 - Must include rhythm guitar and lead guitar (melody guitar) parts.
4. Play a second, shorter performance of an improvisation over either a major chord progression or a blues.

*You are the focus of this video so please make sure your camera is focussed on you and your guitar and the sound quality is adequate enough for us to assess your performance.
Keep your guitar high in the mix.*
