## Video Audition Instructions

Your Music Production audition consists of:

1. A recorded video responding to the questions below
2. Submitted student work (if available)

Questions to answer in your video:

Experience:

1. What experience do you have in music recording, if any?
2. What experience do you have in live sound, if any?
3. What recording or live sound equipment are you familiar with, if any?

Goals:

1. What are your future ambitions and goals professionally?
2. How will attending Visible prepare you for your future goals?

Technical:

1. Explain your understanding of the differences between a producer and an engineer.
2. What is your understanding of EQ, compression, and reverb/delay?
3. What are your objectives when you work on a project? (e.g. recording, mixing, live sound)

Musical:

1. What musical instruments do you play, if any?
2. What kinds of music inspire you?

Academic:

1. How would you describe yourself as a student?
2. What plans do you have to make sure you are academically successful at Visible?

#### Submitted Student Work:

If you have recorded projects, please upload those to the Student Portal where you upload your audition video.

- Upload a written explanation of what work you did on each example
